



Bridging the Gap between Independent Living and a Nursing Home

Independent Living

Residential living setting for seniors that may or may not provide hospitality or supportive services. Residents lead an independent lifestyle requiring minimal or no assistance. Generally referred to as elderly housing in the government-subsidized environment, independent living also includes rental-assisted or market-rate housing where residents usually have complete choice in whether to participate in a facility's services.

Nursing Home

 Provides 24-hour skilled care for more acute patients. Patients generally rely on assistance for most or all daily living activities (such as bathing, dressing and toileting).

Assisted Living

- Senior housing that provides individual apartments.
- Facilities offer 24-hour on-site staff, assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs), medication management, congregate dining, and activity programs.
- Nursing services may be provided by Home Health Care agencies.

Who Needs Assisted Living?

Assisted Living Residents' Specific Needs

- **68% require assistance with bathing.**
- **47%** require assistance with dressing.
- **27%** require assistance with toileting.
- **22%** require assistance with transferring.
- **13%** require assistance with eating.

SCREENING TOOL FOR ASSISTED LIVING

HEALTH CONDITIONS THAT MAY REQUIRE ASSISTED LIVING:

- Advanced Age
- Confusion, mild dementia
- Depression
- Isolation
- Improper Nutrition, lack of nutrition
- Lack of medication management
- Difficulty walking
- Recent falls
- Hypertension
- Heart Disease
- Stroke
- Diabetes
- Cancer (chemo, radiation)

Assistance Provided:

- Dressing
- **Bathing/grooming**
- Toileting/depends
- Meal preparation
- Laundry/housekeeping
- Ambulation: walking, wheelchair, one person transfer
- Medication management
- Doctor's visits
- Safe, supervised residence

Disqualifying conditions:

- Bed bound (two person transfer)
- Permanent feeding tubes
- Colostomy bag
- Requires skilled nursing care daily
